Thank you for your interest in the GMEP, Polly Farmer, Follow the Dream program. The program provides enriched educational opportunities and experiential opportunities for aspirational Aboriginal students, celebrating culture to strengthen a sense of belonging and connection to community.

Students in Follow the Dream must be able to demonstrate:

- consistent good behaviour at school
- regular school attendance
- respect of school staff and their peers
- work consistently and always trying their best.
- · consistently attend after school sessions

Gumala Mirnuwarni Education Project is situated at Karratha Senior High School with tutoring sessions conducted at the end of each day Monday – Thursday. At the end of the school day, students meet where they have afternoon tea and weekly updates.

From 2:45 students are engaged in a range of activities. This may be homework, revision, assignments, or enrichment activities depending on individual student needs. Students are often provided with opportunities to engage with guest speakers, attend workplace tours or be part of workshops. These will usually happen during these after school sessions.

At the end of each session there are opportunities to transport students home. Students may also be picked up by parents/family or nominate to take responsibility for their own travel home.

It is an expectation that students attend regularly however we do understand that some weeks this is not possible. We ask that you communicate with the school if this occurs.
