

Karratha Senior High School - Mobile Phone & Headphones Policy

At Karratha Senior High School we have phones and headphones off and away all day, between the hours of 8:20 – 2:30

If a student has a mobile phone or headphones visible the procedure is as follows:

- 1. Reminder of KSHS behaviour expectations "We have phones and headphones off and away all day, 8:20 2:30"
- 2. If the student has the phone or headphones out again, the student will be asked to turn off their phone and hand it over to their teacher.
- 3. The phone will be placed in an envelope with the student's details written on it.
- 4. The teacher will take the envelope with the phone to the Administration Office before 2pm.
- 5. The administration staff will record the student's name and keep the envelope in a filing cabinet for the day.
- 6. Confiscation 1, 2 and 3 the student can collect their phone at the end of the day.
- 7. Confiscation 4: The parent will be contacted, and they will need to collect the phone at the end of the day. Student Wellbeing Team will email or phone the parent/carer.

If a student refuses to follow a teacher's instructions, then the normal BMiS policy applies.

As per the Department of Education Mobile policy (poster below) there may be circumstances where students <u>can</u> use their phone/headphones.

This needs to be approved by a Head of Learning Area, Student Wellbeing Co-ordinator, Deputy Principal or Principal.

Exceptions are:

- Completion of tasks that cannot be completed on a computer or laptop.
- As part of a student's individual support plan.
